## STAR WARS: LEGION TEAM EVENT

AdeptiCon reserves the right to modify, update, clarify, or change event rules in the interest of making AdeptiCon the best event possible. No fundamental rules changes will be made to the event after 2/1/2020.

Welcome Commanders! You and your teammate have joined forces to defeat your enemies! In this Team Event, you will need to maximize your options and play strategically in order to outwit not one but two opponents at the same time. May the best team win!

### BASIC RULES

- This event will utilize the Star Wars: Legion Rules and documents found on the [Fantasy Flight Games Star Wars Legion Support Page](#), [Official Legion Rules Thread](#) and [FFG Floor Rules Document](#).
- Armies must consist of 800 points or less for each player, using the normal rules for army construction and the addendum in the back of the Rules Reference guide regarding limitations.
- Players will play one 4-hour round. When time is called, the match is over immediately and scored.
- The Loser of the match will report the match slip to the TO desk for all matches, to ensure accuracy of entry.
- Teams must register at the TO table together and provide their team name. Fun is encouraged, subject to TO approval.
- Players will need to play with either an opaque bag or are permitted to shuffle their command tokens and stack, offering their opponent a cut opportunity.
- All players are expected to abide by the [AdeptiCon Conduct Policy](#).
- The models used in your army must comply with the [AdeptiCon Model Policy](#) (all models **MUST** meet the standard 3-colors paint rule).
- AdeptiCon Tournament Judges' and Officers' rulings are final and arguments or poor conduct by players will not be tolerated. AdeptiCon reserves the right to remove players from the event or AdeptiCon itself with no refunds allowed.

### LIST REQUIREMENTS

- Players must submit army composition, including all associated Battle Cards and your Command hand during check-in. Players who do not submit their list before the event will be dropped from the tournament. It is preferable if you use a list builder online and submit the list to the TTO event directly but not required.
- Each player should provide each opponent with a list for review during the 15-minute prep. Players should bring 2 printed copies of their list – One must include Command Hand and Battle Card information (for the TO desk).
- Players are responsible for bringing all the game components they need to play a game of Star Wars Legion. This includes their army, order tokens for each unit, command hand, enough dice for attack and defense rolls (or the licensed FFG dice app), movement tools, and range rulers. In addition, players must bring 12 unique objective, deployment and condition battle cards, four of each type.
