AdeptiCon reserves the right to modify, update, clarify, or change event rules in the interest of making AdeptiCon the best event possible. No fundamental rules changes will be made to the event after 2/1/2020.

Congrats! You've taken your first step into a larger world. You've made it to the World Championship Invitational. This is where things start to get really challenging. You'll be competing with the best from across the globe! May the Force Be With You!

BASIC RULES

- This event will utilize the Star Wars: Legion Rules and documents found on the [Fantasy Flight Games Star Wars Legion Support Page](#), [Official Legion Rules Thread](#) and [FFG Floor Rules Document](#).
- Armies must consist of 800 points or less.
- Day 1 (Heats Thursday and Friday are separate but count as the same event for structure) players will play four Swiss-paired rounds. Each round will be 2.5 hours in length with approximately 15 minutes prior to the match for setup. When time is called, players will finish the game round they are currently playing and need to promptly report their match to the TO desk.
- The Loser of the match will report the match slip to the TO desk for all matches, to ensure accuracy of entry.
- Registered players will be asked to create an account on Table Top TO ([TTO](#)). Once your account has been created, please email the TO at crimson.owl@gmail.com so your profile can be linked with our event.
- **All 3-1 players** from each day 1 heat will be asked to play in 4 rounds of swiss on Saturday, following all the previous instructions, as well as utilizing the same army composition as they did in Day 1.
- The top 4 players from day 2 will be asked to play 2 rounds on Sunday, with winners playing winners and losers playing losers to determine final ranking.
- Players will need to play with either an opaque bag or are permitted to shuffle their command tokens and stack, offering their opponent a cut opportunity.
- All players are expected to abide by the [AdeptiCon Conduct Policy](#).
- The models used in your army must comply with the [AdeptiCon Model Policy](#) (all models **MUST** meet the standard 3-colors paint rule).
- AdeptiCon Tournament Judges' and Officers' rulings are final and arguments or poor conduct by players will not be tolerated. AdeptiCon reserves the right to remove players from the event or AdeptiCon itself with no refunds allowed.

LIST REQUIREMENTS

- Players must submit army composition, including all associated Battle Cards and your Command hand during check-in. Players who do not submit their list before the event will be dropped from the tournament. It is preferable if you use a list builder online and submit the list to the TTO event directly but not required.
- Each player should provide each opponent with a list for review during the 15-minute prep. Players should bring 5 printed copies of their list – One must include Command Hand and Battle Card information (for the TO desk).
- Players must use the same list for the duration of the tournament, throughout all days, including battle cards and command hand cards.
- Players are responsible for bringing all the game components they need to play a game of Star Wars Legion. This includes their army, order tokens for each unit, command hand, enough dice for attack and defense rolls (or the licensed FFG dice app), movement tools, and range rulers. In addition, players must bring 12 unique objective, deployment and condition battle cards, four of each type.
